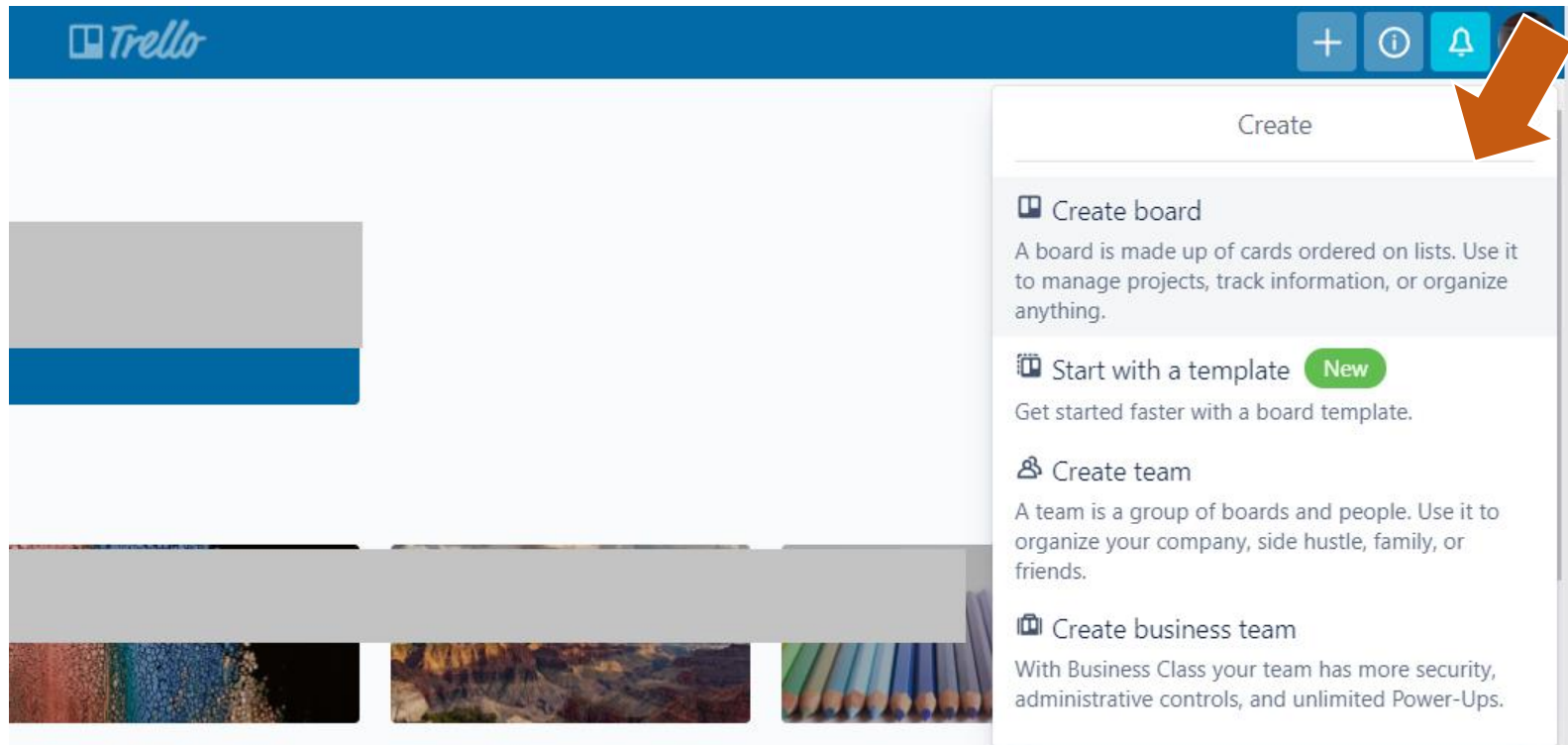

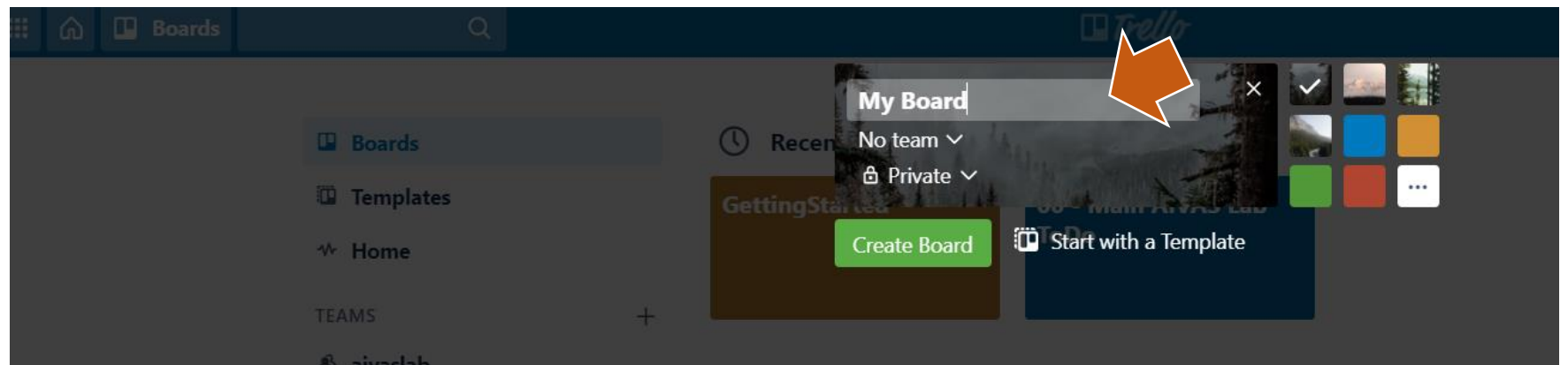
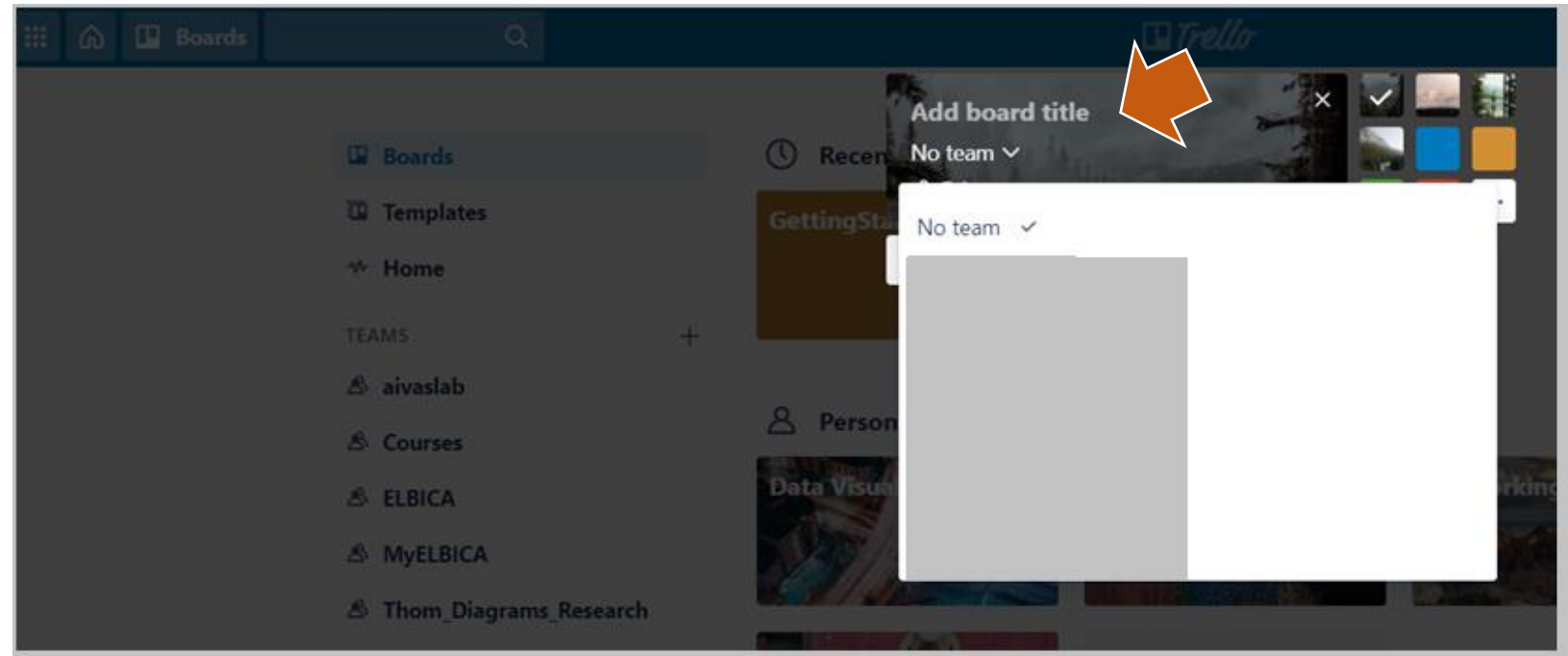
- Once you create your account, DO NOT provide: your full name, job title, department, and organization.
- Be careful while choosing your public name!!!

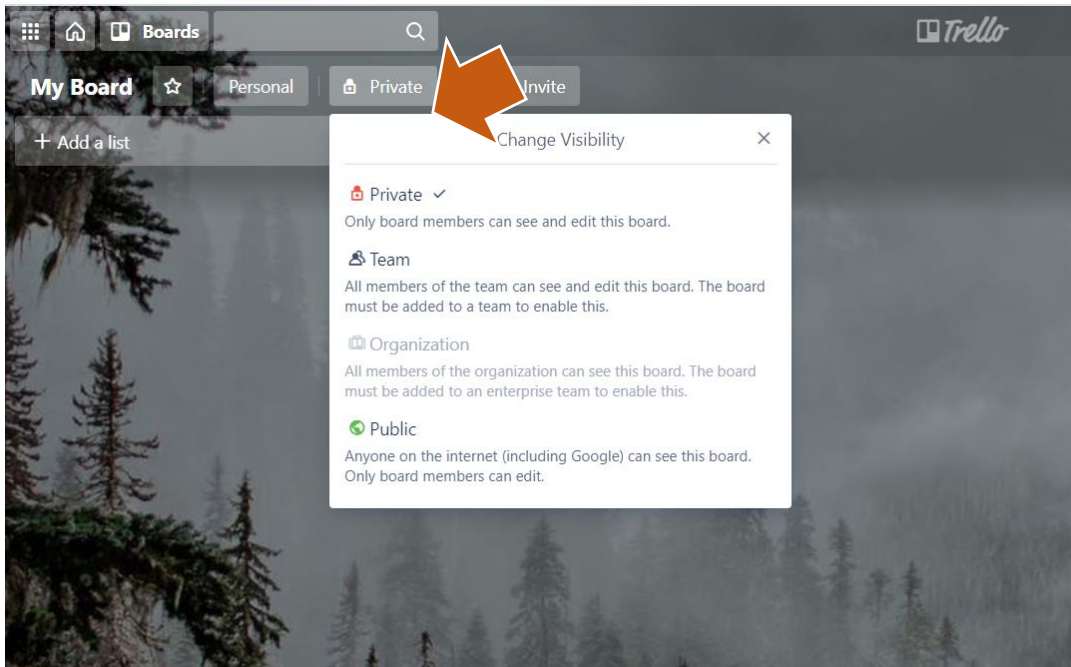
# Trello

- On Trello, you can create a board and set its visibility to either private or public.
- Another option is to create a team and then establish the visibility of the board to the team.



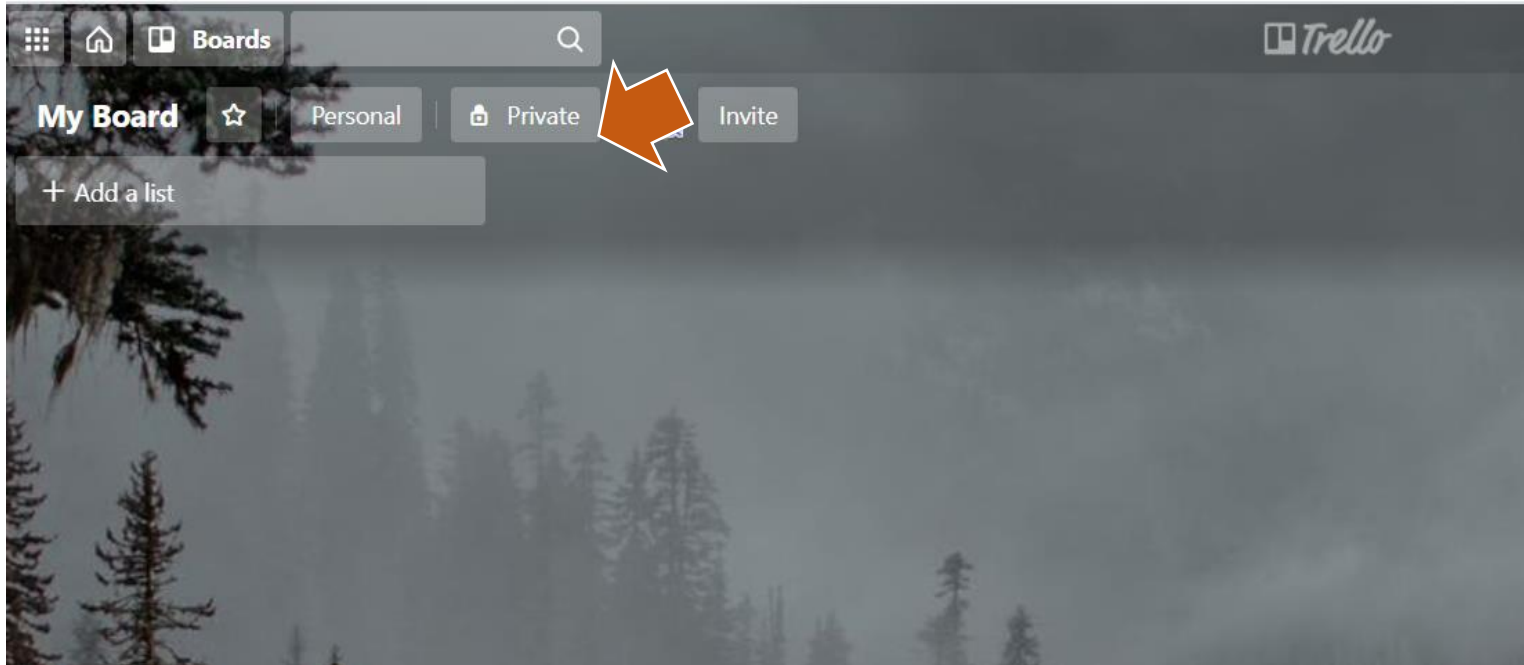
To create a board, you need to choose a title (here, I am using “My Board”) and if it is going to be private or shared with a team. **Choose Private.**





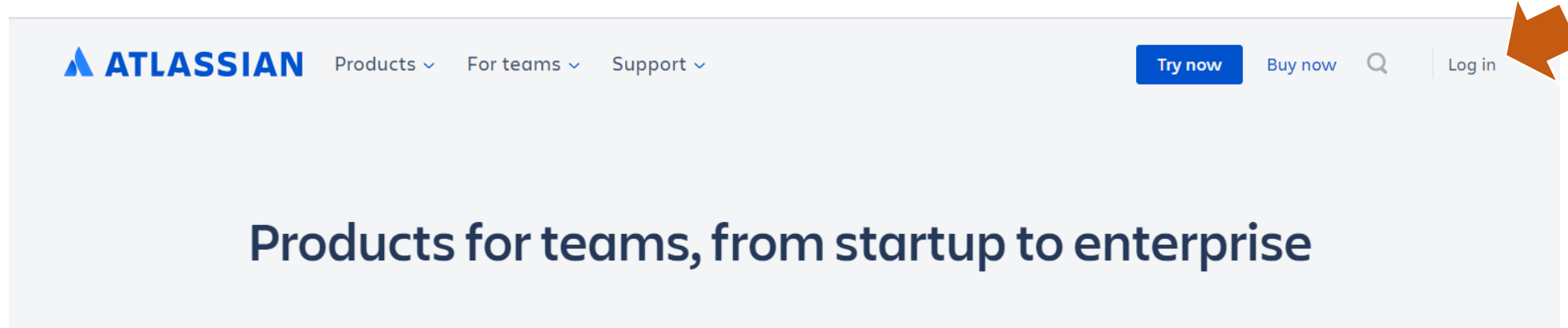
- Now that you have your board, it is time to set its visibility.

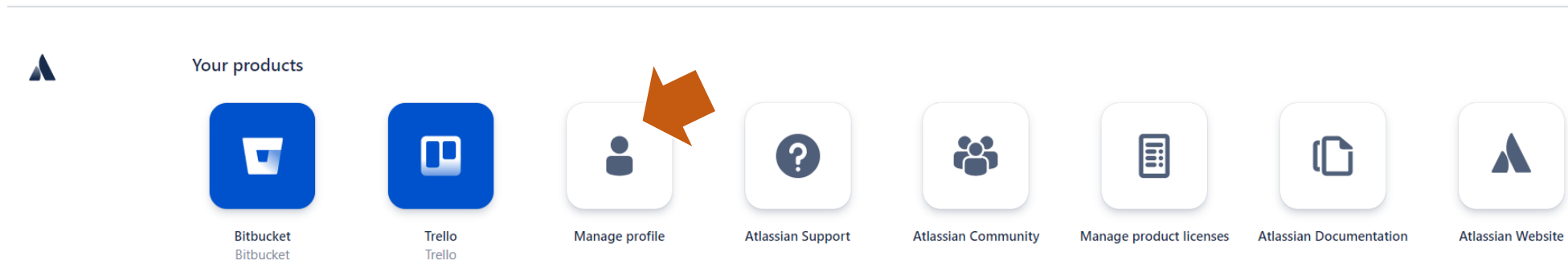

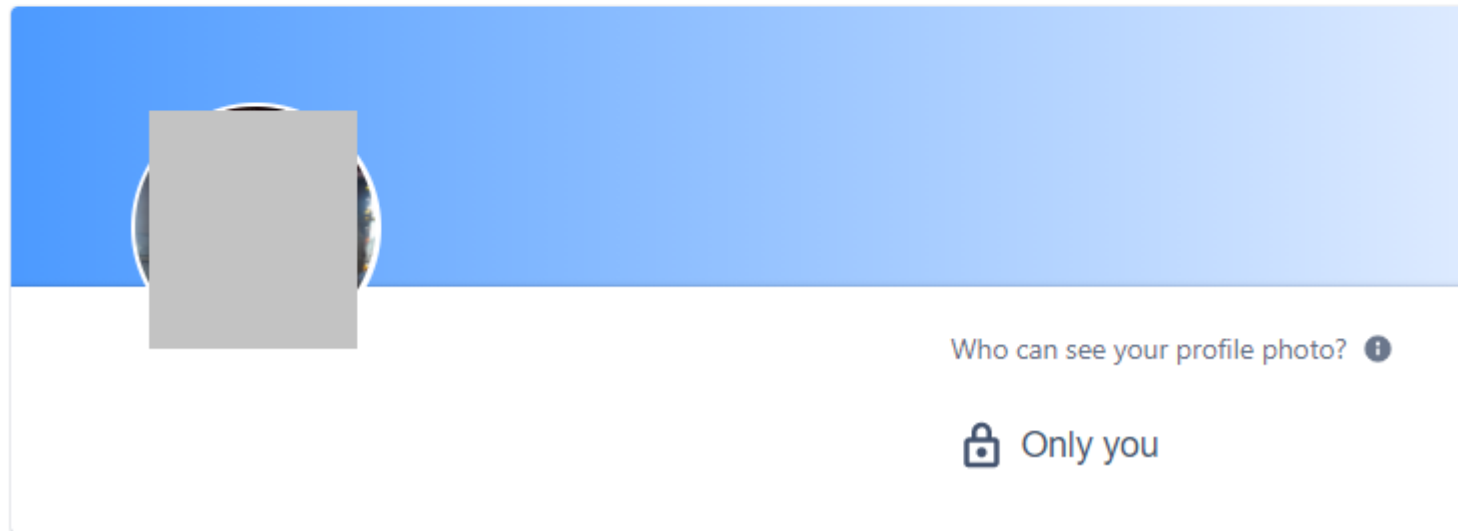
- Profile photo: change to “Only you”
